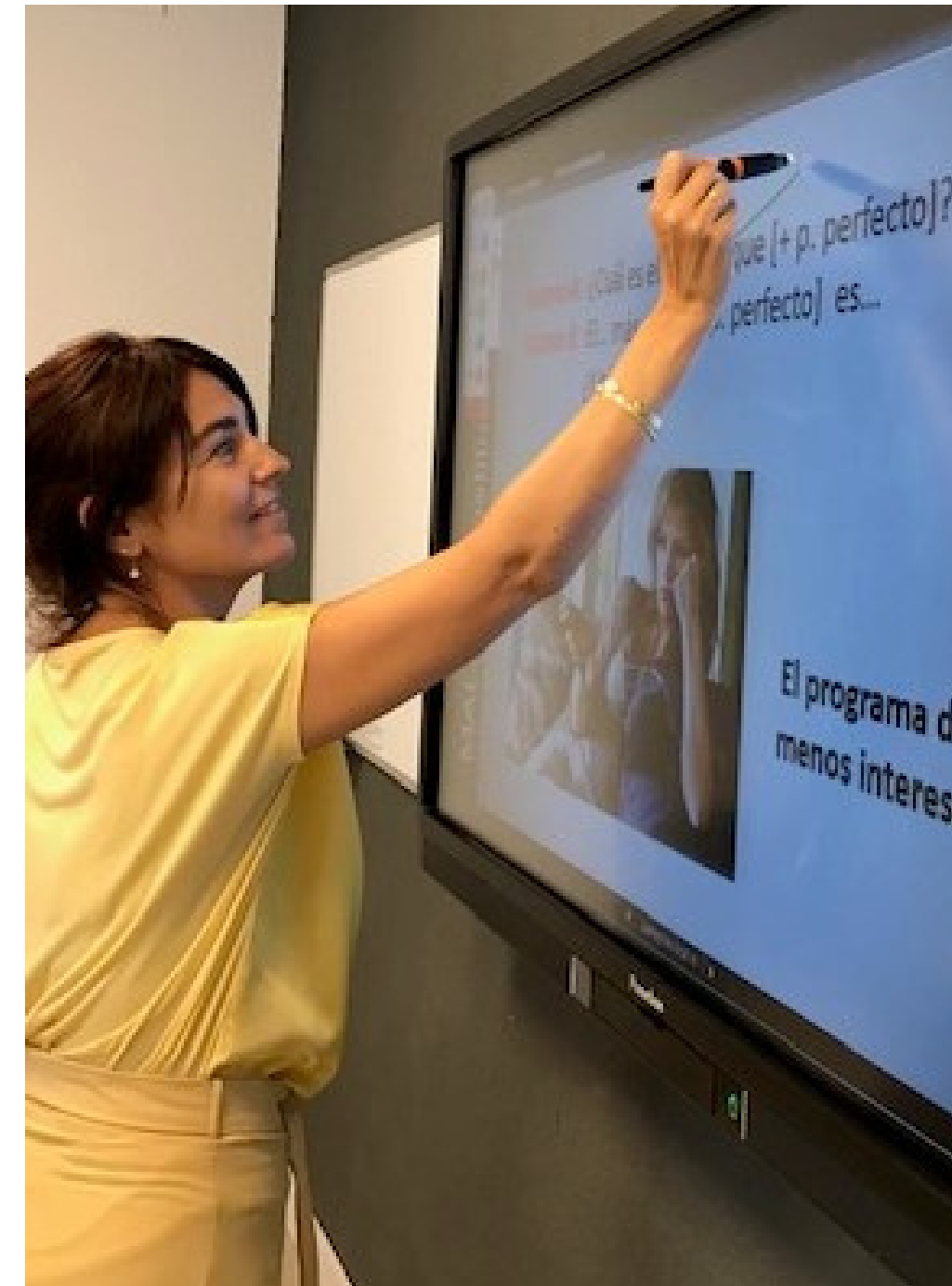
### DAY 2. TUESDAY 04/07/23
